



## Computing Pupil Voice KS2




83% of our children think that computing is important and that they know they need to be able to use technology well.




41% of our children think that they would like to use computers when they leave school.




Over 90% enjoy their computing lessons at least sometimes.




Over 80% say they know what they are learning about in their computing lesions.




91% of our children can save and retrieve their work on the network, but 44% say they need some help.




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
Over 95% use the internet at home.




Over 95% of children think we do a good job teaching them how to stay safe online..




95% of our children feel safe online at least most of the time and 62% feel safe all the time.




Only just over 50% of our children are using the internet to help with homework.




Only 62% of our children think that our digital devices work well.



But nearly 80% of our children think that we have enough digital devices.



96% of the children use computing skills in other lessons at least sometimes.



Over 90% of the children would like to use digital devices more often in their learning.



## From listening to our children we can see that....

- We need to promote the role digital devices will play in the children's lives when they leave school.
- We must ensure ALL children are clear about their learning in lessons.
- We need to make sure that ALL children know what to do if they see something upsetting online.
- We need to make sure our devices are working more of the time.
- We need to increase opportunities to use devices, especially in other lessons.
- We need to increase opportunities to use digital devices as part of homework.
