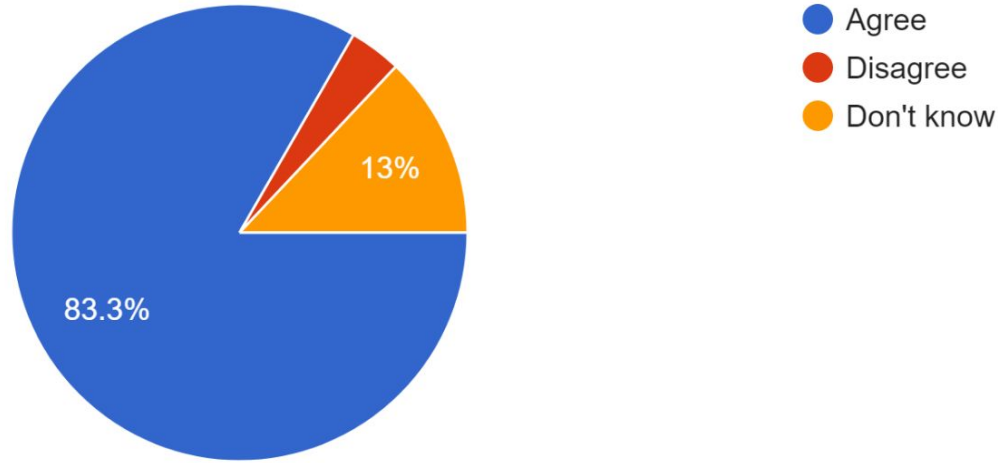

It is important to be able to use computers well

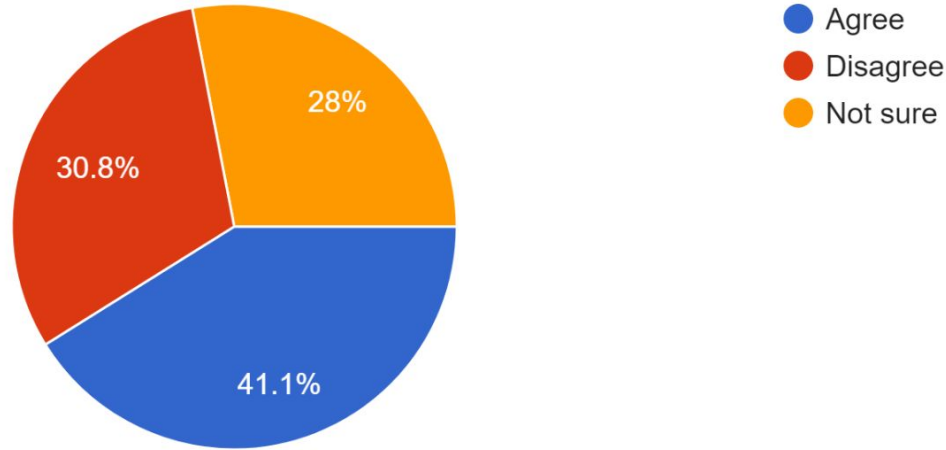
108 responses

When I leave school, I would like a job that uses computers.

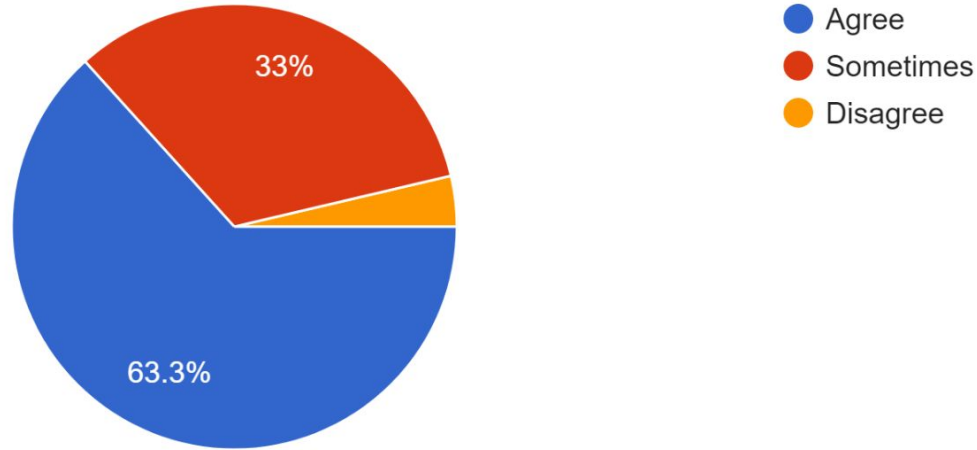
107 responses

I like computing lessons in school

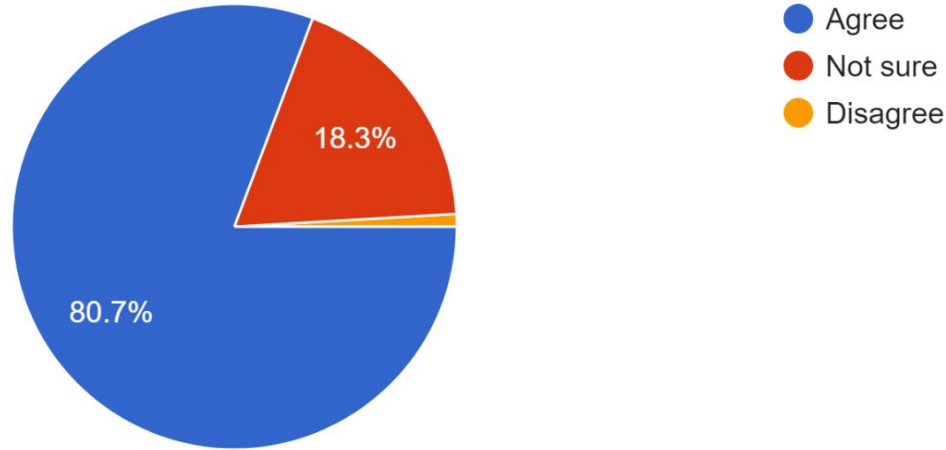

I know what I am learning about in my computer lessons

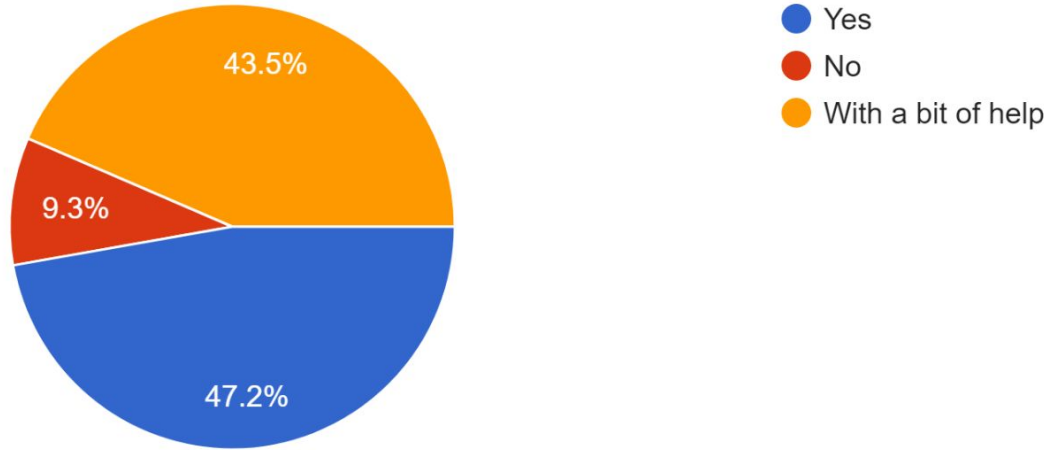

I can save and find my work on the school network

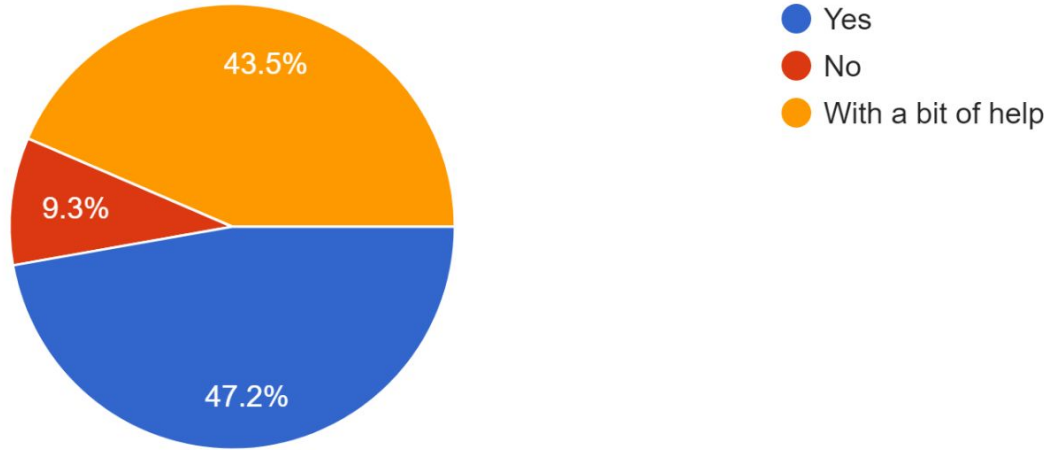
108 responses

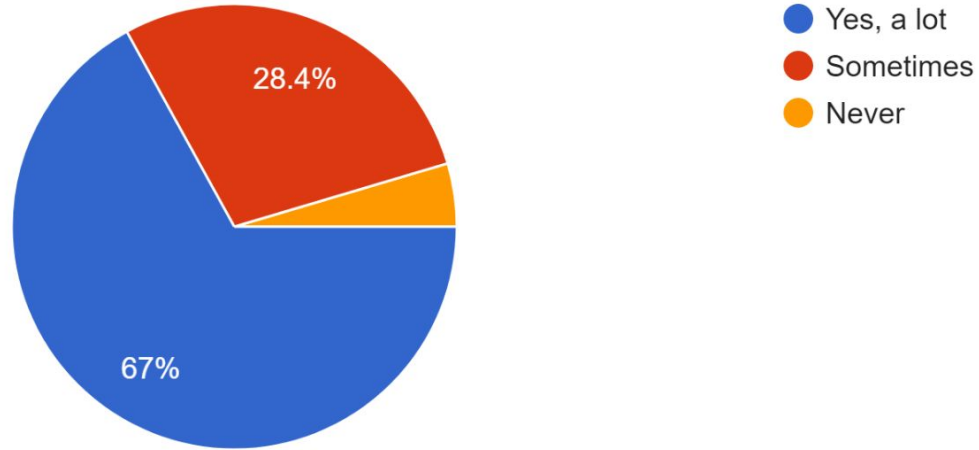

I use digital devices to go online at home

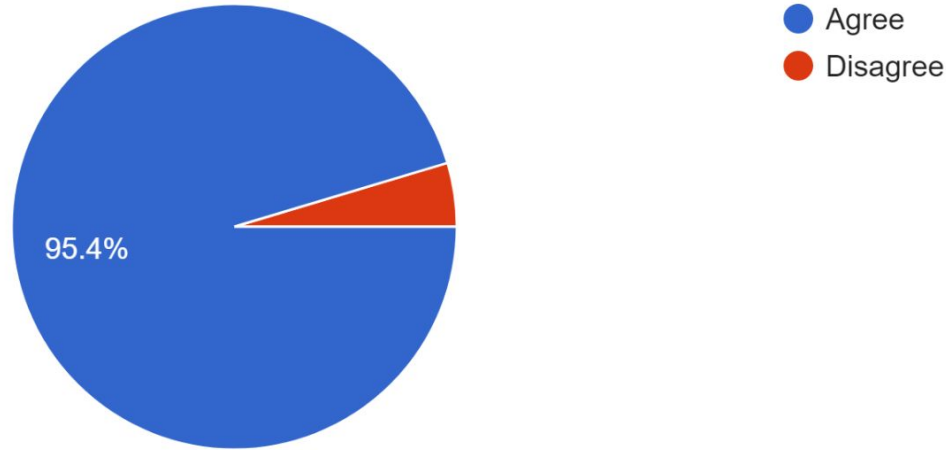
109 responses

The school teaches me how to stay safe online

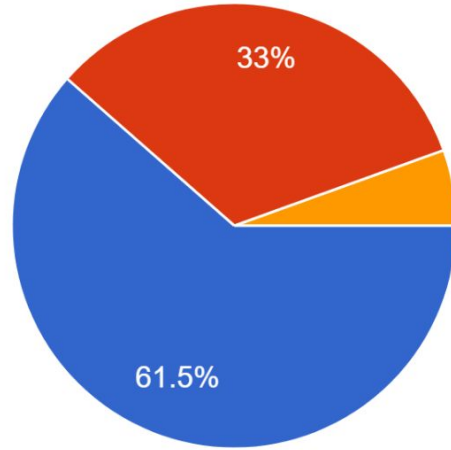

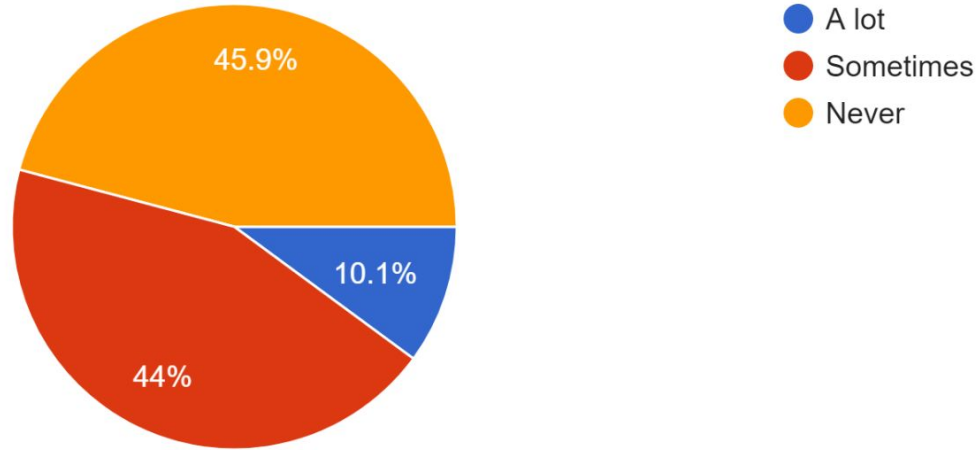


- Agree - I always feel safe

I use digital devices to help me with my homework

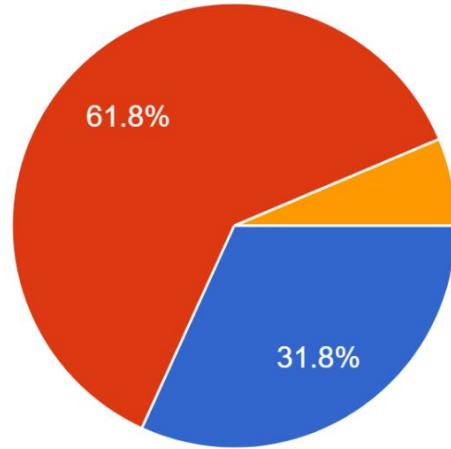

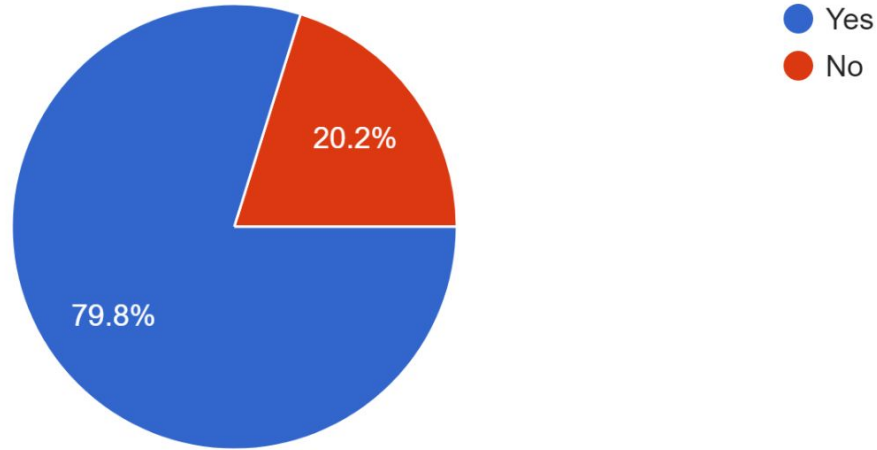


- Agree

The school has enough laptops and iPads

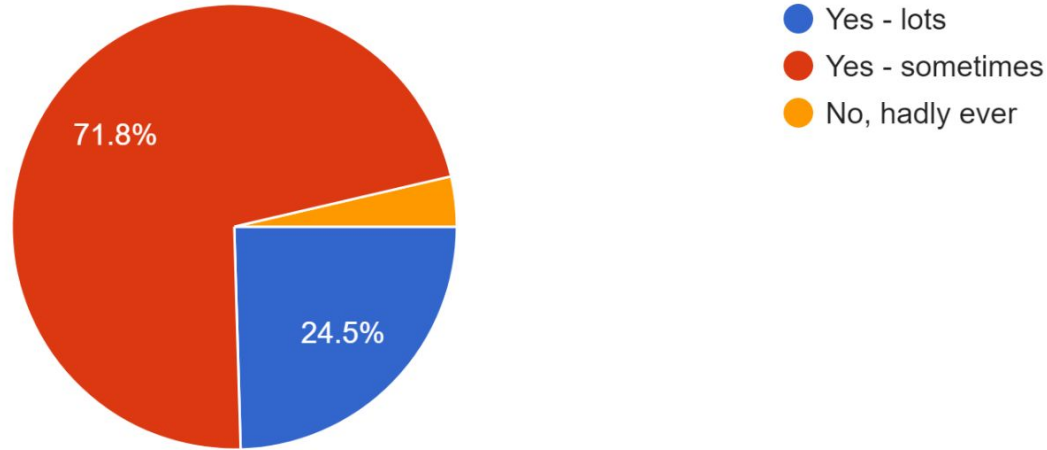

I use laptops and iPads in lots of different lessons

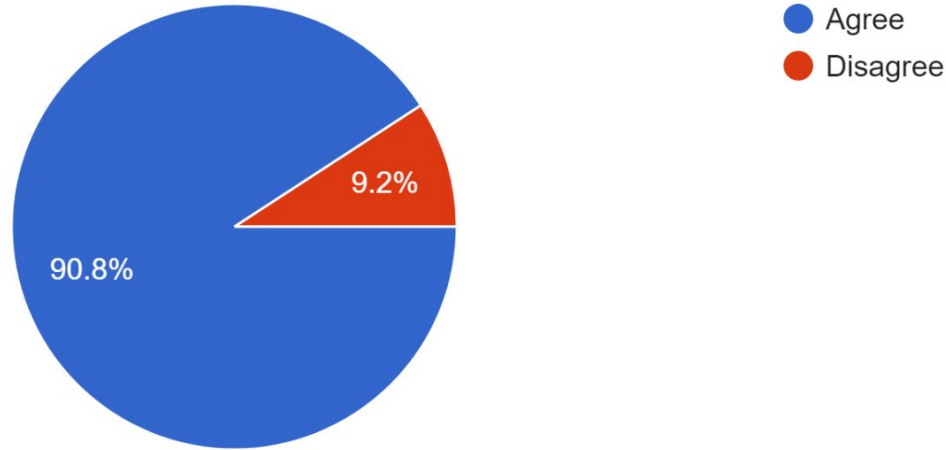

96% of the children use computing skills in other lessons at least sometimes.

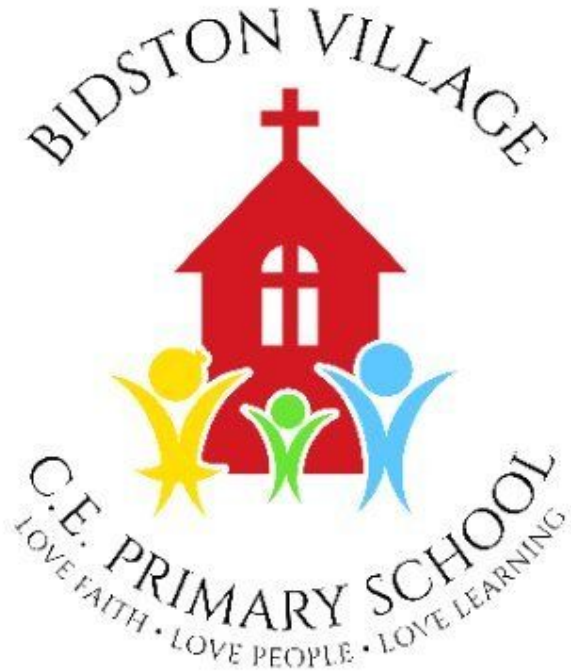
I would like to use laptops and iPads more often in school

From listening to our children we can see that....



- We need to promote the role digital devices will play in the children's lives when they leave school.
- We must ensure **ALL** children are clear about their learning in lessons.
- We need to make sure that **ALL** children know what to do if they see something upsetting online.
- We need to make sure our devices are working more of the time.
- We need to increase opportunities to use devices, especially in other lessons.
- We need to increase opportunities to use digital devices as part of homework.
