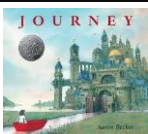


What are we learning about in Summer term?

## Maths



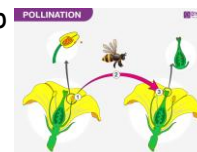
We will be looking at Fractions, Measure, Shape and Statistics. Please encourage us to practise our timetables as much as possible.
