#### The Hive Wirral Youth Zone

All sessions at The Hive are fully inclusive for members with disabilities and additional needs and they have a dedicated inclusion team on every session for those who require additional support. On Sundays they run a dedicated hive ability session for young people aged 8-25 with disabilities and additional needs. This is a family session. Parents and support workers are welcome to stay for those who have higher support needs.

## Koala Northwest

Autism Incredible years is for parents of children aged 2-9 years old, who is on the ASD pathway, or has already had a diagnosis of Autism. Autism Incredible years operates in a group setting, with sessions running on a weekly basis.
