What are we learning about in Spring term?

English

This term we will be focusing on 2 stories. 'Goldilocks and just the 1 bear' is a witty sequel to the traditional Goldilocks story which the children will love! We will also be reading the 'The Curious Case of the Missing Mammoth' and learning all about extinct and endangered animals.

Maths

We will be exploring numbers to 50 (place value). We will then move onto addition within 20, doubling numbers and subtraction within 20. Remember to complete the weekly maths homework.



Science

In science we will be learning about the different seasons. We will be thinking about the changes that happen in each season focussing on winter. We will also be exploring different materials and extending our vocabulary.

Geography

We will be learning all about the United Kingdom and learning more about England. We will be looking at maps and exploring different traditions from all 4 countries. If you have any ... from the United Kingdom that you would be happy for us to lend, let us know!

RE

We will be learning about the importance of forgiveness and repentance. We will also be focussing on Holy Week and celebrating Easter.
