English

This term we will be reading 'Escape from Pompeii' which is a historical story about 2 children escaping the eruption of AD 79. We will be doing lots of work on describing settings and characters. Our grammar work will focus on speech marks and apostrophes.

Maths

We will be finishing our work on multiplication and division before moving onto a really important focus for the year - Fractions! Please make sure your child gets on TTRockstars as much as possible as we are getting ready for the Multiplication Tables Test in May.

Science

In science we will be learning about the digestive system. We will learn the names of the organs involved and will be spending some time learning about the different types of teeth and what they are used for. Hi Impact will be doing a workshop on January 25th.
